NOTIFICATION

As recommended by the Meeting of the Cell constituted for Introduction of Choice Based Credit System at Dibrugarh University held on 04.08.2011, the hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dibrugarh University is pleased to approve the following modifications in the Modified Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Post Graduate Programme in the Choice Based Credit System, 2008 (amended on 08.07.2010) under report to the Post Graduate Board and the Academic Council, Dibrugarh University:

Clause(s)	Earlier	Modified/ newly included
7.3	In in-semester evaluations, two sessional tests shall have to be conducted for each course, which shall carry 50% of the total marks allotted for in-semester evaluations. For the remaining 50% of total marks allotted for in-semester evaluations, course teachers may employ two or more assessment tools such as objective tests, assignments, paper presentation, laboratory work, etc. suitable to the courses. The students are to be informed in advance about the nature of assessment. Students shall compulsorily attend the two In-semester examinations, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for the End-semester examination. A Student cannot repeat In-semester examinations. Provided that if for any compulsive and valid reason a student could not appear in the In-semester examination(s), the course teacher may arrange a special In-semester examination with approval of the Departmental/Centre CBCS Board.	In in-semester evaluations, two sessional tests shall have to be conducted for each course, which shall carry 50% of the total marks allotted for in-semester evaluations. For the remaining 50% of total marks allotted for insemester evaluations, course teachers shall employ two or more assessment tools such as objective tests, assignments, paper presentation, laboratory work, etc. suitable to the courses. The students are to be informed in advance about the nature of assessment. Students shall compulsorily attend the two Insemester examinations, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for the End-semester examination. A Student cannot repeat Insemester examinations. Provided that if for any compulsive and valid reason a student could not appear in the In-semester examination(s), the course teacher may arrange a special In-semester examination with approval of the Departmental/Centre CBCS Board.
9.17	New inclusion	The CGPA earned by a candidate may be converted to equivalent percentage of marks by multiplying the CGPA by 10 (ten).

The above modifications shall come into immediate effect.
